It's not really a museum. It's a house that has been restored, redecorated, furnished and equipped as if it were 1910.

Mrs. Mary Cummings was the tenant of 346 High Street from 1901 to 1930. The reconstruction takes account of the living memories of Mary, her Irish Catholic background and her work as a seamstress at home and at Petworth House.

The museum first opened to the public in 1996. It depends not only on its admission charges but also on the support of the Friends of the Museum.

If you are already a Friend, thank you. If not please consider supporting us by becoming a Friend. Admission charges rose from 2015 but the Friends' subscription remains at £10.



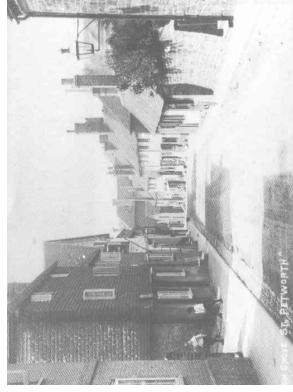
